#### SITE RULES

#### Check In:

Tourer pitches may be occupied from 2pm on the day of arrival until 11am on the day of departure unless otherwise stated. Any change to these arrangements will be notified on your booking confirmation letter. If you do not depart at these times we may charge you a late departure fee. When you arrive please report to reception along with your booking reference/surname.

#### Dogs:

Well behaved dogs are welcome, but they must be kept on a lead at all times. This is due to having sheep and nearby game birds. Dog owners are responsible for clearing up after their dogs and disposing of dog fouling in the bins provided. Aggressive dogs or noise disturbance will not be tolerated

#### Children:

Children under 14 years must be supervised at all times, as this is a working farm with animals and hazards present.

#### **Outdoor Play Area:**

Our outdoor play area is available for our guests to use throughout the duration of thier stay. Please note that Walnut Tree Farm are not be liable for any loss, damage or injury suffered by the use of the outdoor play area. We also request that all children must be supervised at all times and there is no misuse of the facilities that could compromise the saftey of the users/guests.

#### **Guest Courtesy and Conduct:**

Please respect fellow guests and be quiet after 10pm and before 7am.

No Ball Games (including anything that can damage cars/caravans) on the Caravan site.

Don't Climb or Lean on the Gates or Fences (some have an electric wire to prevent animals from reaching through).

Sound producers are not to be played at any time to the annoyance of others especially after 10 pm in the evening.

All indoor areas are strictly non-smoking, this policy extends to the use of vaporisers, e-cigarettes or other similar devices due to their similarities to cigarettes.

## SITE RULES (continued)

You are responsible for the behaviour of all members of your party. Behaviour should be in keeping with the family environment and should not be excessive, noisy or disruptive, especially after 10 pm at night. Offensive, aggressive or illegal behaviour or language towards anyone (including our staff) will not be tolerated and may result in the police being involved.

## Electricity Fair Usage Policy:

At Walnut Tree farm we wish for your stay with us to be as hassle-free as possible and to offer pitch fees that are inclusive of our services and facilities rather than a lower base price with multiple add-ons (i.e. charges for dogs/use of shower etc).

In response to the rising energy costs we have listened to our guests to find a solution that we believe is fair, up-front and honest. As a result we have implemented a policy where we continue to include 16 amp EHU within our pitch fees with the use of Smart Top-Up Meters.

We have added Smart Top-Up Meters to all our pitches and included an allowance of 10 KWH/units of electricity for every 24 hours period that you stay within the pitch fees. Your full KWH/unit allowance will be applied upfront at the start of your stay to the Smart Top-Up Meter, for example 2 nights stay will include 20KWH/units, 7 Nights will include 70KWH/units.

It is important to us that if we offer 16 amp EHU included in our pitch fees that allowance is reasonable and does not lead to extensive top ups as we don't want to inconvenience the majority of our guests. That's why we have researched and found that 10 KWH/units seems to be adequate to cover the average daily usage per caravan or motorhome.

The current status/usage can be viewed via a smartphone or tablet (by simply scanning a QR code) from the comfort of your own caravan or motorhome. If in the event that you need to top up more electricity, this can be purchased without the need to even leave the comfort or your own caravan or motorhome via a smartphone or tablet in the same way as viewing the status. The top up ranges form  $\pounds 2- \pounds 100$  and the cost of the electric is based on the "Government Ofgem Price Cap".

On arrival you will recieve an information sheet that provides instructions and the unique QR code to your meter in order to view balances and make top up payments.

## Walking from our site

There are many walks in the local area and the village of Swanton Morley is a shor walk from our site and boasts a post office and convenience store, butchers and 2 pubs.

As there are no footpaths along Swanton Road (the road along the front access to our site) we strongly suggest to access the local walks and access to the village by walking over our meadows and onto Hoe Road South. Please see overleaf a map of the access to Hoe Road South.

#### Walking on our site

Although our sheep graze the meadows surrounding our site during spring, summer and autumn, they only graze one area at a time therefore you are free to strech your legs or those of 4 legged friends on the areas that are not currently being grazed (however please respect that all pets should be on leads at all times and pleas ensure fouling is cleared up and disposed of in our bins).

During winter months our sheep will be housed and therefore the entire meadows can be used however the fields can be very wet in winter therefore wellingtons or walking shoes will be required.





## From SOUTH (Newmarket/Thetford) take All to Norwich:

# Please note that sat navs may direct you through the town centre of Dereham. We recomend to follow the below route to avoid the town centre and narrow roads.

At Thetford, take the 1st exit from the roundabout from the All onto Al075 Follow road for 21 miles to Dereham, turn right onto slip road to A47 Take exit off A47 onto Norwich Road/signposted to "Swanton Morley" Immediately after leaving exit turn right towards "Swanton Morley" Continue for approx 1.5 miles Turn Left onto Mowles Road/Bl147 towards "Swanton Morley" Turn Left onto Swanton Road After approx. 250m turn right in Walnut Tree Farm, Swanton Road, Dereham NR20 4PT



## From EAST (Norwich) take A47 to Kings Lynn:


